Very tedious trail breaking on the up and deep-surfing on the down. Just a pile of sugar that's going to get real spooky with any new snow on top of it. Upper trail over/around all the deadfall on the way out was sport death. No injuries that can't be fixed with Ptex. Good day.

ps, parking lot was unplowed. Any idea whether that's done directly by USFS or contracted out? It is going to get real tight later in the season if the pandemic-driven crowds materialize as has been predicted.
