There was a large, [deep slab avalanche](#) snowboard triggered in Lone Lake Cirque this afternoon (3/30). The [slide](#) ripped in a secondary start zone below ridgetop, and ran far into the flats, and may have run a bit uphill, where it encountered the rock glacier moraine in the runout. It looks to be a R4, D2.5. Snowboarder walked away unharmed.
